PADDLER CODE OF CONDUCT Please Read This!

- 1. I will practice **good sportsmanship** behaviors and will encourage others to do the same.
- 2. I will **be respectful** to every person associated with CCDBA, CCDBA boats and equipment, other teams, event officials and the public. If I disagree with someone, I will do so respectfully. If I have a grievance, I will follow the <u>CCDBA Grievance Procedure</u>.
- 3. I will **support the mission of CCDBA** by cooperating with and abiding by its <u>Safety</u> <u>Guidelines</u> and <u>Policies and Procedures</u>, and by volunteering when possible.
- 4. I will be a **positive ambassador** for my team and CCDBA when attending events hosted by others. This includes cheerfully following the rules and directions of the hosts and venues.
- 5. I will abide by the **CCDBA non-discrimination policy**.

(CCDBA can not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, sex, national origin, creed, ethnicity, age, physical or mental disability, political affiliation, sexual orientation, medical conditions, genetic characteristics, gender identity, marital or domestic partner status, veteran status, or any other basis protected by law.)

Kevin and Roe support us in SO many ways! We respect their business by staying off the dock except when absolutely necessary; and we load/unload the boats quickly and quietly.



Basic Boat Safety...

- Steersperson is in charge of safety; listen to and follow his/her commands. Steers override coaches.
- Always wear a ZIPPED UP life vest (PFD) on the dock and in the boat.
- Quiet on the boat during loading/start and docking/unloading.
- Changing sides: Right paddler stands up, keeping low as possible while moving; Left paddler slides over.
- Getting out of the boat: wait for instruction before getting out. If a teammate offers you a hand, grasp each other just below the elbow.
- CCDBA Safety Guidelines
- Covid Policy: Stay away if you are sick; contact <u>president@ccdba.org</u> if you test positive within 5 days of being on the boat.

How to Use TeamSnap

• Look in your email for the invitation to sign up on TeamSnap. Get the TeamSnap app for your smartphone. It's easy to use, but if you want more details, click here: <u>TeamSnap Instruction</u>.

• **TeamSnap is for team-related communication:** practices, races, events, meeting notes, cancer support opportunities (but not for selling your used car).

- **Sign up for team events** listed on the schedule by clicking the green 'Going' button. If you have to cancel, click 'NO' as soon as you can.
- READ TeamSnap emails. If practice is cancelled or someone donates a million bucks, you want to know, right? Right!!

What Else is on TeamSnap??

Team Roster: handy if you need to email your coach or teammates.

Click on Media/Files to find:

- Photos! (Proof that dragon boating is fun!)
- Team Leadership information/meeting notes
- Racing Information (what to expect at a race)
- CCDBA Nonprofit info: Policies and Procedures, Safety Guidelines, Directors and Committee Chairs roster, Budget, etc.

What does SurviveOars 'TLC' Do?

- Plans for SurviveOars team participation in local, national and international festivals (races).
- Plans team parties, social paddle events, memorial paddles.
- Selects head coach. The head coach establishes the practice schedule, and trains assistant coaches and practice coaches.
- Takes the lead in selecting team 'swag' like shirts, hats.
- Leads quarterly meetings of the team; meeting dates/times are announced on TeamSnap.
- Communicates policy and budget requests from the team to CCDBA Board.

FAQs: Other Things You Might Want To Know...

- 1. Where do I get a SurviveOars team shirt/other swag? There's an online Team Store periodically; watch for TeamSnap announcements. If you want to buy your own pfd, the team chose BLUE as the team pfd color.
- 2. **Can I go to races/festivals?** YES, your Race Coordinator Alex will list available races on TeamSnap; any Team Paddler can sign up. Paddlers pay their own travel costs.
- 3. **Can I bring a friend to practice?** YES! FIRST, make sure your guest goes to CCDBA.org to submit the 2025 Liability Waiver. To sign up your guest for practice on TeamSnap,text Tracy P at (310)480-8894.
- 4. What if I know a group who wants to paddle? Susan (<u>scheduling@ccdba.org</u>) can set up a 'Special Paddle' for groups of 8 to 18 people.


